Questions (with Answers)

1. How can refusing to believe Christians can be oppressed by demons affect us?

We can't be set free from something that we refuse to admit exists.

2. What can create areas in our souls that the enemy can hang on to?

Unresolved negative emotions or any area that is out of alignment with God.

3. Is it possible to have psychiatric symptoms from the oppression of demons?
Is it normal to be under constant pressure and attack from the enemy when we are doing the Lord's work and taking over enemy territory?

Yes and No.

4. Why isn't it helpful or necessary to use a loud or dramatic voice when doing deliverance?

It can be shaming to the person we are helping and our effectiveness is based on our authority not our speaking style.

5. Why do almost all Christians have reason to be oppressed by the enemy?

Because all have sin, and all have trauma or abuses in their lives where the enemy has gotten an opportunity to hold on. Unresolved negative emotions are also a place where he can get an easy foothold.

6. Why does having a person repent of cooperating with sin make the deliverance much easier?

It gets rid of the ground or reason for the demon to be there.

7. What is the difference between binding a demon and casting it out?
