

# Autobiography—Charlie Lee

## I. Salvation Decision:

I accepted Christ when I attended college in Santa Monica in 1998 during the first fall semester. A college pastor from Chinese Evangelical Free Church first introduced me to Christianity, then my friendships in church continued to point me to the Gospel.
